You're going to get a spicy kick out of this one! The Eagle Tavern, new to the food scene in downtown Pottsville, has a kitchen staff with years of experience, and it shows across the menu. Thick housemade onion rings compliment the housemade BBQ sauce that is infused with a local porter beer. Gouda cheese is a good choice for this one. We skipped the pickled rellish and if there were any changes we'd love to see...It's a thicker bun that can carry the weight of such an tasty burger. Served with french fries so good we ate them first.



The grill at OIP Pottsville is on fire with this Hawaiian infused angus burger that we orderded with an extra beef patty, just because. Ham and pineapple, with lots of cheese, made this burger stand out from the rest on the menu. You could tell the ham and pineapple made a stop on the grill before meeting up with the 8-ounce beef patties. We got ours Medium. We were trying to decide what kind of dipping sauce would go best with this one. Maybe a dipper on the side of southwest ranch?
